The Criminal Investigations Division is developing an eligibility list for the position of Digital Forensics Unit Detective. This position conducts systematic and complex technical investigations involving a highly technical set of skills relating to computer forensics. They serve as a resource to agency members by providing technical expertise for investigative techniques, seizure, collection, and preservation of evidence. The detective works independently or with other members of the division, participates in regular training, and attends specialty schools as required. The DFU Detective will be assigned to the DFU Lab and conduct investigations in support of the Sheriff's Office mission, which may include supporting units outside the Investigations Division and from other agencies.

The selection process will consist of an oral board, Practical Skills Assessment, Personnel and Professional Standards file reviews, and extensive technical skills performance review.

All qualified Deputies will be notified as to the specific date and time they are to appear before the interview board. Personnel selected for this position will be required to successfully complete the PTO/FTO process prior to transferring to the Digital Forensics Unit.
