Following selection, the candidates must successfully complete a POST Law Enforcement Driving Instructor Program at a date to be determined.

Deputies who wish to be considered must:

- Submit their online application, including a one-page resume.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have an endorsement from current supervisor.
- Not currently on any type of disciplinary probation and not currently on a Performance Improvement Plan (PIP).
- No sustained major disciplinary action within the past year (suspension or demotion).
