Dear Private Property Owner/Manager:

The El Paso County Sheriff's Office can enforce certain violations of C.R.S. or County ordinances occurring on private property without the owner/manager being present by having a letter on file with the El Paso County Sheriff's Office. Examples of these ordinances are parking on private property, trespass on private property, and littering on private property. If you desire enforcement action during normal and non-normal business hours, you must complete the following and be willing to testify in court, should the need arise. Signing this does not guarantee additional patrols and the Sheriff's Office will need to be informed when there may be a violation on the property. This authorization will expire two years from the date of signature. If you wish for this authorization to continue beyond this date, you must renew this authorization every two years.
