POSITION TITLE: Detention Chaplain

SUMMARY OF FUNCTIONS: Provide spiritual worship service, studies, and counseling to the inmate population at the El Paso County Jail.

1. Provide spiritual counseling to inmates.	Frequent
2. Facilitate worship services to the inmate population.	Frequent
3. Lead and teach bible studies to the inmate population.	Frequent
4. Provide one-on-one sessions to the requesting inmate population.	Frequent
5. Provide guidance to inmates through religious/spiritual avenues.	Frequent
6. Help provide donated literature pertaining to the program.	Frequent

Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be over the age of 21.
- Strong desire to help others and commit to weekly groups and/or guides.
- Must have strong verbal and communication skills.
- Must successfully pass local and national background checks.
- Ability to complete the online CJIS Security Awareness Training.
- Complete the El Paso County Jail's orientation and probation.
- Attend Annual Volunteer Training through Programs.
